

## LICENSE PLATE MOUNT FOR ROLLER FAIRLEAD



INCLUDED PARTS	QTY	REQUIRED TOOLS
Molded License Plate Holder	1	Drill Motor
Molded Nylon Spring Clips	2	1/4" Drill Bit
Hardware Pack	1	Phillips Head Screwdriver



- 1. Place Molded License Plate Holder on a flat surface.
- 2. Use the template provided to drill two 1/4" holes where noted. Make sure the template is flush to the bottom and roughly centered on the License Plate Holder.
- 3. Mount the Molded Nylon Spring Clips to the back of the License Plate Holder (Fig 1.)
  - a. The top holes use only the #12 Pan Head screws.
  - b. The bottom holes use both the #12 Pan Head screws and the large washer.
  - c. Tighten the screws securely to the Molded Clips—Hand tighten only, No Power Tools.
- 4. Install the two Molded Nutserts into the License Plate Holder top slots (Fig 2.)
- 5. Install license plate into the License Plate Holder. Using the screws located in your vehicle's glove compartment, or the screws provided, secure the license plate to the License Plate Holder.






